



RESOLUTION NO. 15-395

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RURAL CITY SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR 2016-2021 FOR STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY OF LA CENTER

The City Council for the City of La Center adopts the following findings:

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.47.020 grants to La Center, and other non-charter code cities, broad authority to establish, layout, widen, extend, keep open, improve, maintain and repair streets, sidewalks, and other public ways; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.77.010, the City of La Center has prepared a comprehensive transportation program for the next 6-year period, 2016 through 2021, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the La Center City Council held a duly noticed public hearing at its April 8, 2015 regular meeting/public hearing to consider and adopt a Six-Year Transportation Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, based on the foregoing findings, the La Center City Council adopts the Rural City Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2016-2021, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Clerk shall file a copy of this Program with the Secretary of Transportation not more than 30 days after the date of this Resolution.

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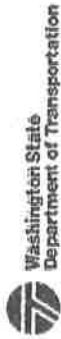
