

## DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS) La Center Road Sanitary Sewer Construction

**Description of proposal:** The City of La Center owns and operates a municipal sewer utility and roadway network. The project consists of extending a sanitary sewer collection system within La Center Road right-of-way between the publicly operated treatment works to where La Center Road and NW Paradise Park Road intersect.

Proponent: City of La Center

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The project will be constructed within La Center Road between 101 Aspen Avenue, the location of the publicly operated treatment works facility and NW Paradise Park Road.

Lead agency: City of La Center

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and proposed plan document, LCMC 18.300 Critical Areas, and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public upon request.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of publication, October 26, 2016.
