

DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS) La Center Critical Area Code (LCMC 18.300) Update (File # 2019-023-SEPA)

Lead agency: The City of La Center

Description of proposal: Non-Project Action to amend La Center Municipal Code (LCMC) chapter 18.300 relating to the designation and protection of critical areas consistent RCW 36.70A.060(2) and (3). The amended critical area regulations shall be based on best available science consistent with RCW 36.70A.172.

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: All lands within the La Center city limits which may be classified as critical areas consistent with RCW 36.70A.030(5).

Proponent: City of La Center

The City of La Center has determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2). An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). The SEPA DNS comment period will end on October 01, 2019.

The La Center City Council will conduct a Public Hearing on the proposed amendments to LCMC 18.300 at a date to be determined.
