Overview

Under the exemption program, the assessed value of your property is frozen for tax purposes and you may be eligible for a reduction in your property taxes. This could be worth thousands of dollars in savings for you. The program is retroactive and will not place a lien on your property. Contact us and we will walk you through the process to determine your eligibility and the level of your exemption.



Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible you must meet the following requirements on December 31st of the year before the tax is due:

At least 61 years of age

OR

Unable to work because of a disability OR a veteran entitled to and receiving compensation from the VA at an 80 percent disability rating for a service-connected disability

AND

You must own your home and reside in the home as your primary residence for a minimum of 6 months a year





Income Levels



Exempt from excess levies and Part 2 of state school levy

LEVEL 1

You are exempt from paying regular property tax on greater of \$60,000 or 60% of the assessed taxable value.

LEVEL 2

You are exempt from paying regular property tax on greater of \$50,000 or 35% of the assessed taxable value, not to exceed \$70,000.

LEVEL 3

You are exempt from paying excess levies.

Household income is calculated using the combined disposable income earned during the application year for you, your spouse or domestic partner, and any cotenants.

Note: All income levels are for 2020 taxes and forward.
