

## SEPA DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

La Center Middle School Critical Areas Permit (File # 2019-033-CAR/SEPA)

Lead Agency: City of La Center

Responsible Official: Greg Thornton, Mayor of La Center

**Description of Proposal:** The Applicant seeks critical areas permit approval to permit temporary and permanent wetland impacts associated with the previously approved conditional use permit application (file no. 2018-027-CUP) for a new middle school of 77,725 square feet. Permanent impacts to wetlands associated with proposed improvements also include landscaping, roads and pedestrian access, parking, utilities, and other required infrastructure serving the new middle school. Temporary impacts will include removal of soil contaminated with Dieldren in wetland A-S on the south part of the site, placement of clean fill material, and replanting the wetland and associated buffer with native vegetation.
