

# CITY OF LA CENTER, WASHINGTON NOTICE of PUBLIC HEARING

Low Density Residential (LDR-7.5) Front Setback Code Updates (File #: 2023-018-ZON/SEPA)

The City of La Center is updating its code provisions pertaining to Low Density Residential (LDR-7.5) Front Setbacks. The purpose of the code update is to provide the option to reduce the minimum front setbacks when providing additional architectural features. The front setback code updates are including:

- Requiring all dwellings allowed in the LDR-7.5 zone to provide a minimum front-loading garage setback of 20-feet, regardless of the minimum front yard setback; and
- Adding a review process for a project that opts to use the reduced front yard setback provisions.
- A features list including architectural and design elements such as:
  Covered porch area, dormers, pillars/posts, variable siding, belly band
  cladding, knee/eave braces, varied exterior wall offsets, , bay windows,
  recessed building entry, and more.

The hearing will be held on **Tuesday, August 8, 2023, beginning at 6:30 PM**. The City has modified the hearing and public testimony procedures to meet the Hybrid Meeting requirements. **The hearing will be conducted in-person at 210 E 4th Street La Center, WA 98629 and online via GoToMeeting (a video conferencing service).** Participants do not need internet access and can connect by phone.

The public is encouraged to provide written or oral testimony. Directions for participating are included under the "Remote Hearing Attendance and Public Testimony" section below.
