Description of Proposal <u>Clark Public Utilities performs many repairs, upgrades existing facilities, reconductoring</u> electric lines and other maintenance and operational activities of its infrastructure and facilities on a regular basis. Many of these activities involve routine maintenance and repair activities such as tree pruning, vegetation management, chemical usage, mobile refueling and pole replacement within critical areas and shoreline jurisdiction. Some of these activities are associated with emergencies such as power outages, service interruptions, and general public safety. Clark Public Utilities is proposing a memorandum of agreement with the City of La Center to authorize the routine maintenance and repair activities within critical areas and critical areas associated with shoreline jurisdiction.

As part of the memorandum of agreement, Clark Public Utilies has prepared a critical areas management plan that will provide a means for the efficient, reliable and effective continuance of current and future activities associate with the routine maintenance and repair activities while complying with the Critical Areas Ordinance, Chapter 18.300, and the critical areas ordinance codified into the Shoreline Master Program. The proposed memorandum of agreement would be valid for 5 years.
