

SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE Barnhart Annexation and Rezone (File # 2023-038-ANX)

Description of proposal: The applicant is proposing to annex approximately 14-acres into the City of La Center. The annexation area consists of one tax parcel, parcel number 209479000. No development is proposed at this time. The La Center Municipal Code requires that the site be zoned Low Density Residential (LDR-7.5) with an Urban Holding (UH-10) overlay following annexation. The UH-10 overlay limits development on the property to one single-family dwelling per 10 acres and the overlay will remain in place until certification from the public works director or city engineer that any identified capital facilities deficiencies have been satisfactorily resolved. In accordance with RCW 43.21C.222, annexations are exempt from review under SEPA, but rezones must undergo a SEPA threshold determination under LCMC 18.290.030.

SEPA Determination: The City of La Center issued a **Determination of Non-Significance (DNS)** for this proposal pursuant to WAC 197-11-340 and the La Center Municipal Code (LCMC 18.310). An Environmental Impact Statement is not required under RCW 43.21c.031(1).

Any person has the right to comment on this SEPA DNS, receive notice of and participate in any hearings. Written comments submitted by January 24, 2024 at 5:00 PM will be considered. Statement of Determination: As lead agency under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) rules [Chapter 197-11, Washington Administrative Code] the City of La Center must determine if there are potential significant adverse environmental impacts associated with this proposal. The options include the following:

- Determination of Significance (DS) The impact cannot be mitigated and therefore requires the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).
- Mitigated Determination of Nonsignificance (MDNS) The impact can be mitigated through conditions of approval, or;
- Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) The impacts can be addressed by applying the city codes.

Approval Standards/Applicable Laws: La Center Municipal code section 18.30 (Procedures).

Mitigation Measures: The applicant will be required to comply with all applicable approval standards and laws in addition the following project-specific mitigation measures:

• <u>Public Services and Utilities</u>: Prior to removal of the UH-10 overlay, the applicant is required to demonstrate that adequate public services and utilities are available or can be provided prior to or concurrent with development of the site in accordance with LCMC 18.190.060.
