Temporary Use Code Updates (File #: 2022-027-ZON/SEPA)

The City of La Center is updating its code pertaining to Temporary Use Permits contained in LCMC 18.265. The purpose of the code update is to provide more flexibility on temporary use permit extensions and expiration as well as specifying exempt uses that do not require a temporary use permit. The following list specifies the proposed updates to the Temporary Use Permit code contained in LCMC 18.265.

The hearing will be held on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 beginning at 6:30 PM. The City has modified the hearing and public testimony procedures to meet the Hybrid Meeting requirements. The hearing will be conducted inperson at 210 E 4th Street La Center, WA 98629 and online via GoToMeeting (a video conferencing service). Participants do not need internet access and can connect by phone.
