A COVENANT to the City of La Center, State of Washington, hereinafter "City," by the owner(s), Felida Rose LLC, of certain real property identified in Exhibit "A" on behalf of themselves and all their heirs, assigns and successors in interest into whose ownership said property may pass, agrees that this covenant shall run with the land. It is the purpose of this covenant that certain wetland, wetland buffer, and designated mitigation located within areas shown in Exhibit "B" labeled as Wetland D, will be maintained in a protected state as follows:

- A physical demarcation and Signage along the upland boundary of the Wetland D area shall be installed and thereafter maintained. Such demarcation may consist of logs, a tree or hedge row, fencing or other prominent physical marking approved by the Responsible Official for the City. Any change to the type of demarcation shall similarly be approved by the Responsible Official.
- 2 Consistent with the purpose of this covenant, no person, company, agency, or applicant shall alter the wetland except as exempted in Section 3 below or authorized by the Responsible Official through an approved Wetland Permit.

- 3 Exempt Activities and Impacts to Wetlands. Developments, activities, and associated uses listed in LCMC 18.300.090 that are located outside designated wetland mitigation areas shall be exempt from the provisions of this covenant; provided, that reasonable methods are used to avoid potential impacts to wetlands and buffers and these activities are otherwise consistent with the provisions of other local, state, and federal laws and requirements. Exemptions from This covenant are not exemptions from wetland stewardship responsibilities.
- 4 Monitoring and Maintenance of Mitigation. Wetland D mitigation sites subject to this covenant are required to be monitored and maintained in accordance with the mitigation plan or conditions of approval of the associated City Wetland Permit.
- Nothing in this covenant shall be construed to provide for public use of or entry into the wetland or buffer areas shown on Exhibit "B". However, representatives and agents of the City are hereby authorized to make reasonable entry upon such land for purposes related to administering this covenant: provided that owners or their heirs, successors or assigns are given at least 24-hours advance notice of any such entry.
- The provisions of this covenant are enforceable in law or equity by the City and its successors.
- This covenant and all of its provisions, and each of them, shall be binding upon the owners and any and all of their heirs, assigns and successors in interest into whose ownership the above-described real property may pass, and any obligations made herein by owners, shall be enforceable against all of their heirs, assigns and successors in interest into whose ownership the above-described real property may pass.
